



**Four Corners Guides Antiquities Agreement**  
**Four Corners Guides**

At Four Corners Guides, we have a zero tolerance policy in regards to taking, stealing or defacing antiquities. All ruins, petroglyphs and pictographs are considered by Four Corners Guides to be "do not touch or take anything" areas. You must leave all artifacts exactly where you found them. Human contact can and does degrade these artifacts, structures and paints used to make the pictographs found in these sensitive areas. All Four Corners Guides tour guests must sign this agreement in advance of your tour. If we catch you stealing artifacts or defacing ancient ruins, petroglyphs or pictographs, we will not hesitate to report you to the authorities, remove you from the trip (at your expense) and ban from all future FCG tours. There may be times you will be able to handle and photograph artifacts on the Ute Mountain Ute Tribal Park, with permission from the guides. You are never allowed to touch petroglyphs or pictographs.
